# **SCHEDULE INFORMATION & TIMELINE 2021-2022**

There will be no schedule changes permitted from September 8-10.

### September 13-15

NO Schedule changes will be permitted or accepted unless there is an error in a core subject (English, Math, Science, Social Studies). ALL students must REMAIN in their scheduled courses for the first full week of school.

### September 15-17

Counselors will work with seniors regarding Early Release/Delayed Arrival. ALL seniors are to remain in Study Hall until their counselor reviews graduation requirements & credits. A Microsoft form will be made available once your counselor reviews your transcripts. \*Early Release/Delayed Arrival is NOT guaranteed. Students may request it, but if they are scheduled in a required course during Blocks 1 or 4, we may not be able to change their schedule.\*

#### September 15-24

Fall window for Schedule Change Requests will ONLY be accepted through Microsoft forms. \*Counselors will visit study halls and provide the classes available for that block – but students must REMAIN in study hall until schedule changes can be made.\*

## September 27

Deadline for a student to enter a new course.

## September 27

Deadline for a student to drop a course without penalty.

## After September 27

On this date and any date after, a student dropping a course will receive a WP (withdrawn passing) or a WF (withdrawn failing) on their transcript. \*Please NOTE – any student failing a course that wishes to attend summer school and/or credit recovery, MUST remain in the course for the entire year.\*

- \*Due to social distancing and COVID 19 safety protocols, we may NOT be able to fulfill all schedule changes requested.\*
- \*Requests to change a class to a different block cannot be accommodated.\*
- \*Requests to have or drop a particular teacher will be denied.\*
